GENERAL SITE INFORMATION

Directions

Directions to the loading doors: Rt. 890 to Broadway exit. Follow the signs for Proctors. At the first traffic light, stay in the center lane and continue on Broadway. Turn right onto Clinton. The loading doors will be on your left at the intersection of Clinton and Smith Streets. Tall Vehicles SHOULD NOT approach State St. via Erie Blvd. as there is a low bridge. Larger vehicles can find separate driving and parking instructions within tech package folder.

Loading

3 Standard loading doors at street level USR (ramps req'd) 13' High x 9' Wide 1 Standard loading door USL to load from Stratton Plaza

The main loading area is USR. Immediate access to stage is via a standard door USR.

USL loading door to stage area is approx. 75' from the main loading area via the crossover.

1 4,600lb. capacity forklift with 6' and 8' extensions

Parking

The loading dock can accommodate 3 vehicles side by side. Bus parking is available in the loading dock or on Broadway in front of the Lottery Building. Personal vehicles can be parked in the Parking Garage located across Broadway from the Lottery Building, accessible by Hamilton St.

Shore Power

2 50amp outlets are located on the exterior of the loading dock between doors 2 and 3. An additional 50amp circuit can be made available with advance notice.

Theater Access

Stage Right

- 3 Bay Loading Area, generally only open during load-in and load-out.
- Company Entrance, just to the right of the loading area and generally the main entrance for touring productions. Only unlocked during crew and show calls. **Stage Left**
- Single Bay Loading Area, only open during load-in and load-out.
- Plaza Door, located directly under the Stratton Plaza marquee. Generally used during load-in and load-out or as an exit only.
- Stage Door, located on the right side of the Arcade hallway just inside the Stratton Plaza entrance. Generally manned by Production Management and unlocked during crew and show calls.

House

- Down Stage Right Doorway, the only access to the house directly from stage.
- Lobby Door, the main entrance into the house from the Arcade.

ADA ACCOMODATIONS

Wheelchair/Mobility Aid Accessibility FOH

- Both our State Street and Stratton Plaza entrances have button activated door openers to allow easy access into the building.
- Directly across the Arcade from our Box Office is an elevator that can get you up to the Balcony level of the theater and the FOH entrance to the dressing room hallway.
- At the back of the Orchestra section of the theater there are 4 wheelchair accessible platforms with movable seats for any accompanying caregivers. There are also accessible areas in both the left and right Loge areas by Rows F and G; and accommodations can be made in the pit if asked/required.

Wheelchair/Mobility Aid Accessibility Backstage

- When entering through the Stratton Plaza Doors, the interior stage door is immediately to the right (directly across from John Keal Music Store) and ramps down to the stage level.
- Upstage Left in the crossover is a red freight elevator that will get you up to the dressing room floor.

Hearing Assistance

- Our assisted listening system is through GalaPro.
- A T-coil hearing loop is installed in the theater and assisted hearing devices are available for loan at our box offices.

ASL Accommodations

- If an ASL interpreter has been requested for your show, the will always be positioned in the House Left Loge (as pictured here).
- Lighting in the loge will be adjusted as necessary on the day of the requested performance.

Room 207	Catering room, or second chorus room, 18' x 40'. Has additional kitchen area with range, microwave, sink, and refrigerator. Data/phone ready. Located next to 2 private bathrooms.
Room 213	Large private dressing room, "L" shaped 18' x 18' minus the private bathroom area. Has 4 make-up stations, sofa, chair, coffee table, end table, floor lamp, sink, lavatory, shower, and com station. Data/ phone ready.
Room 214	Same as Room 213
Room 216	Typically used as the hair work room. Approximately 21' x 15'. Contains a utility sink and is data ready.
Room 217	Typically used as the wardrobe room. Approximately 24' x 18'. Contains 3 sinks with mirrors and is data/phone ready.
Room 218	Laundry Room with 3 washers, 3 dryers, and a utility sink.
Room 273	Small private dressing room, 12' x 12', with a door connecting it to Room 274. Contains 3 make-up stations, com station, and is data ready. Nearby chorus restroom.
Room 274	11' x 12' space with sink and 4 make-up stations. Shares a bathroom and shower with Room 275.
Room 275	Same as Room 274.

- Room 277 8' x 13' space with 4 make-up stations, sink, com station, and is data/phone ready.
- Room 278 Small private dressing room, 8' x 15'. Contains 5 make-up stations, sink, bathroom, and shower.
- Room 280/Two 11' x 12' spaces connected by a small crossover, sharing a bathroom281and shower. Each space contains a sink and 6 make-up stations.
- Room 282 Ensemble dressing room with 11' x 13' of usable space. Contains 6 makeup stations and is data ready. Generally used as the company management office.
- Room 283 13' x 16' room containing 7 make-up stations and sink. Shares a bathroom with Room 284.
- Room 284 8' x 8' space with 3 make-up stations. Shares a bathroom with Room 283.
- Stage Level Green room with private bathroom located SL. Can be made into a dressing room with advance notice. Data ready.
